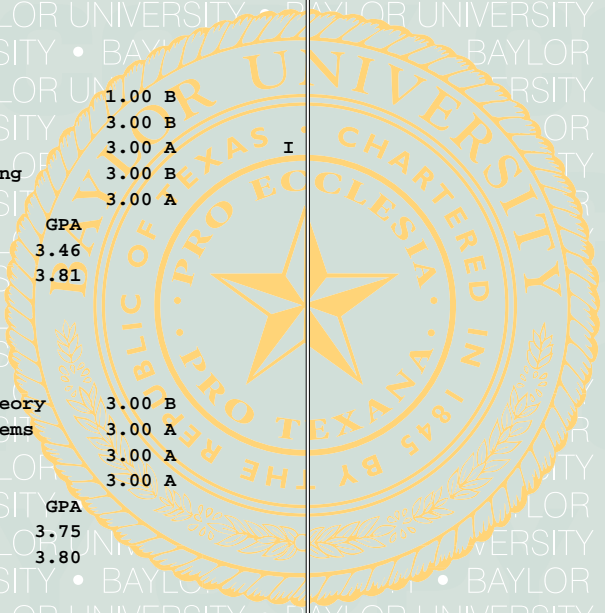

**ACCREDITATION**

**ACADEMIC CALENDAR**

Baylor University operates on a semester system, and all credit is computed in semester hours. The School of Law operates on the quarter system, and some Graduate School programs operate on unique calendars.

**REPEATED COURSES**

Although all grades appear on the transcript when a course is repeated, only the last grade received will be included in calculating the GPA for undergraduate and seminary students. Prior grades received will be marked in the Repeat column (labeled RPT on the transcript) with the letter E, indicating this grade is excluded from calculating in the GPA. The last grade received will be marked with the letter I, indicating this grade is included in calculating the GPA. In calculating the GPA for graduate students, an average of both grades is used. In calculating the GPA for Law students, the second occurrence of a course (indicated by an asterisk next to the grade) can only earn grade points that correspond to a grade of 'C'.

**POLICY REGARDING ELIGIBILITY TO RE-ENROLL**

The student is considered to be in good academic standing unless otherwise noted.

**GRADES, GRADE POINTS, AND GPA CALCULATION**

The grade point average (GPA) is calculated by totaling the number of grade points earned and dividing by the number of credits applied toward the GPA. The resulting grade point average is truncated following the second decimal (e.g., 1.99672=1.99). The University does not round the GPA. This method of calculation is used for all academic purposes such as academic standing, graduation, and scholarship eligibility.
