Instructions for your appointment at the U.S. Embassy in Beijing

Your appointment for a visa interview has been confirmed. The appointment time above is the time you are expected to arrive at the Embassy, not the time that you will have your interview .

- If you arrive up to 30 minutes before or after your appointment time, the Embassy will admit you for your interview.
- If you are more than 30 minutes late, you will be asked to reschedule your interview for another day.

Please be on time.

Every person attending the interview must bring a copy of this confirmation page. If you are feeling ill, please do not enter U.S. Embassy buildings and reschedule your appointment instead.

Note: If there is any inconsistency between the DS-160 barcode number on your appointment confirmation and the barcode number on your DS-160, or if you did not submit a complete DS-160 application when you scheduled your visa appointment, the Embassy cannot process your application. You must reschedule your appointment using consistent information. Any applicant who modifies the information on their interview confirmation letter will not be allowed to proceed with their interview and will need to make a new appointment.

Photo Requirements

Please ensure your photo was taken within the last six months and reflects your current appearance. The Embassy will not accept photos that do not reflect your current appearance. Telecodes

Please ensure your Chinese name's telecodes are written on your DS-160 confirmation page.

Student and Exchange Visitor Visa Applicants

F, M, and J visa applicants must pay their SEVIS fees before their visa interviews. The fee may be paid at [FMJFee.com](https://fmjfee.com) (<https://fmjfee.com>). In compliance with new regulations, all F, M, and J visa applicants are requested to set their social media profiles to public and provide usernames and/or direct links to all active and inactive social media profiles. This information is required to facilitate the processing of your application.

L Visa Applicants

Principal applicants of a blanket L petition or petition-based visa applicants (L1A, L1B, L2) must pay fees at the time of the interview with the Embassy cashier.

Prohibited Items

The following items are not permitted inside the Embassy:

- Smart Glasses
- All Bluetooth/WiFi/electronic devices are prohibited, whether powered on, or off. Bluetooth devices include, but are not limited to smart watches, fitness trackers, smart pens, voice recorders, or any other devices that have Bluetooth, WiFi, or any other remote transmission capability. This also includes electronic keys, building access cards, or any device that has the ability to record or communicate remotely.
- All food or drink items, including bottled water (baby formula/food are permitted)
- Earplugs, headphones or any other listening devices (hearing aids are permitted)
- Sealed envelopes or packages
- Cigarettes, cigars, match boxes, lighters
- Sharp objects such as scissors, pen knives or nail files
- Weapons or explosive materials of any kind
- Other items at the discretion of security staff

The Embassy cannot store prohibited items for you.

Passport Pickup

Applicants may choose to collect their passports from any CITIC location or opt for EMS home delivery.

If you have already scheduled an appointment online, but wish to modify your document delivery address, you can do so by selecting Change Address (<https://www.ustraveldocs.com/cn/en/step-6#change-delivery-address>) in your GSS Profile. You may change your document delivery address or document pick-up location at any time prior to 11:59 p.m. on the day of your interview at the Embassy or Consulate.

Interviews for Minors Under 14

Starting June 10, 2025, all applicants who are under 14 years of age and are applying for a nonimmigrant visa at the U.S. Embassy or a U.S. Consulate General in China must schedule an interview and appear for their interview with at least one parent. They may no longer use the Interview Waiver process. They must also bring the originals (not copies) of the following documents to the interview:

- Minor's birth certificate.
- Household registration book (hukou 户口), if applicable.
- At least one parent's identification document (passport or shenfenzheng; ideally both parents' current and former passports).
- Parents' marriage certificate, if applicable.

签证面谈预约及相关说明

- 您的签证面谈预约时间已确定。上述预约时间是您需要到达使馆的时间，而不是面谈时间。
- 如果您按预约好的面谈时间前后30分钟内抵达，使馆将允许您进入面谈。

但是，如果您迟到30分钟以上，您将会被要求重新预约面谈时间。

请您务必准时。

每一位申请人都需要携带此预约确认信参加面谈。如果您感到身体不适请不要进入美国大使馆大楼，而是需要重新安排预约。

注意：如果您预约确认信上的条形码与申请表(DS-160)的条形码不符，或您在预约签证面谈时没有提交完整的DS-160申请表格，使馆将不能受理您的申请。您必须使用与上次一致的信息重新预约面谈时间。此外，任何申请人一旦自行更改预约确认信上的任何信息将不被允许参加面谈，需要重新预约新的面谈时间。

照片要求

学生和访问交流学者类签证的申请人

F, M和J类申请人在面谈前必须支付SEVIS费。此费用可在 FMJFee.com (<https://fmjfee.com>) 网站上支付。所有申请F类、M类及J类签证的申请人需在其DS-160签证申请表中, 将所有活跃及非活跃的社交媒体账号设置为公开状态, 并提供用户名和/或直接链接。

L类的申请人

如果您是持Blanket L的主申请人或其它L批件类 (L1A, L1B, L2) 的申请人, 您需要面谈时在使馆收银处支付相关费用。

禁止携带物品

以下物品不得带入大使馆:

- 智能眼镜
- 禁止携带所有蓝牙、WiFi及电子设备, 无论其处于开机还是关机状态。蓝牙设备包括但不限于: 智能手表、健身追踪器、智能笔、录音笔或任何其他具有蓝牙、WiFi 或任何其他远程传输功能的设备。这还包括电子钥匙、门禁卡或任何具有远程记录或通信功能的设备。
- 食品, 包括瓶装水 (允许携带婴儿配方奶粉/食品)
- 耳塞、耳机或其他监听类设备 (允许携带助听器)
- 密封信封或包裹
- 香烟、雪茄、火柴盒、打火机
- 剪刀、小刀或指甲刀等锋利物品
- 任何种类的武器或爆炸性物品
- 其他由安保人员决定禁止携带的物品

使馆不能为您保管禁止携带的物品。

护照领取

申请人可以选择其他中信网点取件或者选择EMS专项送达上门服务。

如果您已经在线安排好了面谈时间, 但希望修改您的文件送达地址, 您可以在您的账户中选择“更改地址” (<https://www.ustraveldocs.com/cn/en/step-6#change-delivery-address>)。您可以在大使馆或领事馆面谈当天晚上11:59之前的任何时间更改您的文件送达地址或文件领取地点。

未满14岁的申请人参加面谈

自2025年6月10日起，所有未满14岁且将在美国驻华使领馆递交非移民签证申请的申请人须在预约后由至少父母一方陪同面谈。他们将不再符合免面谈代传递的资格。他们还需携带以下原件（非复印件）一同出席面谈：

- 未成年申请人的出生证明
- 户口本（如适用）
- 父母至少一方的身份证件（护照或身份证；最好是父母双方的现护照和旧护照）
- 父母结婚证（如适用）
